## Second Baraza Session

Baraza 2 brought delegates together for a final round of reflection and collaboration, centering on the theme of building peace through empathy and understanding. The session opened with the Animal Story Chain, which allowed the delegates to discuss and curate solutions to conflict relating to man vs. animal, and how they could mitigate destruction of the ecological balance and minimise its impact.



From there, the Four Corners of Conflict challenged delegates to examine real-life scenarios, encouraging them to take a stand and defend perspectives that were sometimes different from their own. This was followed by the opening of the time capsule done in the first session with a twist, while opening it the delegates had to follow tickets given to them which decided their role in a simulation of a social hierarchy. This helped delegates learn about social inequalities and show how unfair privileges cause conflicts. These activities allowed students to think critically, share openly, and connect deeply, ensuring that Baraza 2 was not only about discussions but also about experiencing the values of respect and collaboration in action.
