THE SCHOOL

DAIS is an English medium, 8-12 co-educational, private, non-profit day school founded in 2003. It is fully accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS) and New England Association of Schools and Colleges. (NEASC). DAIS fosters a learning environment that encourages students to realize their potential while supporting their holistic development, with a focus on academics, well-being and meaningful community engagement. Through the joy of learning, the school nurtures intellectual curiosity in diverse ways and instills lasting values. The DAIS motto is, 'Dare to Dream, Learn to Excel'.

CURRICULUM

- Grades 8-10 follow the Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) programme, with Grade 8 serving as a foundational year. In Grades 9 and 10, we also offer the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) programme, which will be phased out by 2026.
- Grades 11 and 12 follow the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP).

ADMISSION

New admissions to DAIS are selective, and completed through a process of application, testing and interactions.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

DAIS follows a semester calendar, with Semester 1 running from mid-August to January, and Semester 2 from February to mid-June. The senior class graduates in early June. Final high school transcripts are sent to attending institutions in the first week of June, while official IB Diploma results are forwarded in the first week of July.

HIGH SCHOOL COURSE LOAD

- Grades 9 & 10: ICSE (8 courses)
- Grades 8: IGCSE (foundation year 9 courses)
- Grades 9 & 10 IGCSE: (Minimum of 8 & maximum of 10 courses)
- Grades 11 & 12: All students enroll in the IB Diploma Programme, undertaking six courses over two years (3 at Higher Level and 3 at Standard Level), along with Theory of Knowledge (TOK), the Extended Essay, and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS).

STUDENT OPPORTUNITIES

We encourage students to pursue their passions beyond academics through sports, co-curricular activities, community service and student-initiated projects. Opportunities to lead and collaborate include experiences such as Student Council, Model United Nations (MUN), Robotics, TEDx Youth@DAIS, Round Square, the Annual Day production, and international student exchange programmes. Community service is integral for all classes, encompassing service projects in underserved schools & communities, and local NGOs. Our sports programme spans local, national, and international competitions in sports such as Soccer, Basketball, Cricket, Golf, Equestrian sports, Gymnastics, Skating, Yachting, Judo, Taekwondo, Karate, Swimming, Tennis, Table-Tennis, Chess, Squash, and Badminton. The school has a robust Robotics Programme that fosters the students' creative and innovative problem-solving capabilities. The strong DAIS alumni community enriches student learning through mentorship, internships, and personalized guidance.

GRADING

In Grade 8, 9 and 10, IGCSE = A^* to U (with A^* the highest), and ICSE = % marks. In Grades 11 and 12 the IB awards Grades 1 to 7 (with 7 being the highest).

RANKING AND CGPA CALCULATION

Students at DAIS are not ranked. However, those who have attended DAIS from Grades 9 to 12 receive an unweighted Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA), calculated based on their academic performance over those years, using a 4-point GPA conversion table outlined on the high school transcript. For students who join DAIS in Grade 11 for the IBDP programme, their previous school records are submitted through our application platform, and their DAIS transcript reflects a CGPA for Grades 11 and 12. Final IB results are not factored into the CGPA calculation

UNIVERSITY APPLICATION LIMITS

At DAIS, we believe that both students and universities benefit when informed choices are made early in the application process. Therefore, we limit our seniors to applying to a maximum of 12 colleges worldwide. This ensures that each application from a DAIS student reflects genuine interest, allowing colleges and universities to recognize their commitment.
