#### Aim

To provide high school students the opportunity to have their research papers edited, expert reviewed and published in a scientific journal on the school website.

## **Subject matter**

All articles to be accepted must be related to a field within science, technology, engineering and/or math (STEM).

## **Submission requirements**

- 1. No primary data collection must be done and also no experiments must be performed by students for the academic journal.
- 2. The submission should have between 2 to 8 US Letter pages (excluding the appendix and bibliography).
- 3. The submission must be your own work, not intended for any school assignments or elsewhere.
- 4. No specific format or scientific method is required but an abstract, hypothesis, methods, results, conclusion, etc. may be included in your submission.
- 5. The submission should avoid errors in grammar, logic and mathematical calculation.

## **Formatting requirements**

- Times New Roman, size 12
- Double-spaced
- 1-inch margins
- Single column

#### Value to submitter

Unlike most scientific journals, the DAHSJS is not just open to, but exclusively directed towards authors in high school. It provides them with a platform to showcase their research publicly and in doing so, gain recognition. This is a novel opportunity, especially for students in India.
