Raahil Mullick of Class 5B ranks #1 in India, #1 in Asia in U-11 Chess

#DAIS **student,** ten-year-old **Raahil Mullick**, of **Class VB** has displayed high level of chess since November 2017 where he defeated much higher rated players in the National U11 Chess Championship and gained 132 Elo points.

Recently Raahil participated in 3 back to back tournaments – first in the IIFL Wealth GM Chess Tournament in Mumbai, where Raahil gained 104 rating points. He then travelled to the Czech Republic to participate in the prestigious Prague Open Masters tournament. He played fighting chess and increased 68 ELO points.

Raahil finally participated in the Marienbad Open tournament, the second tournament in his Czech tour. Raahil continued his attacking play and again increased 56 ELO rating points.

The latest February 2018 FIDE World Ratings List now places Raahil at rank #1 in India, #1 in Asia and #3 in the World in the Under 11 category with a rating of 2053 ELO points.
