#### ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority is the Corps of Engineers Sailing Club (CESC) in conjunction with the 420 Class Association of India, Little Bay Sailing & Rowing Club (LBSRC) and the Sailing Association of Maharashtra (SAM)

## **NOTICE OF RACE**

- I. RULES
- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Class and Championship Rules of each International Class Association will apply except for any that are altered by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions
- 1.3 No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.











#### 2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising and / or bow numbers chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. These shall be displayed as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open for participation in any of the following events -
  - **420 Class** Men & Women (All India Inland Championship 2016, national ranking event)
  - Sail Board Men & Women (All India Inland Championship 2016, national ranking event\*)
  - Topper Class Open (All India Inland Championship 2016, national ranking event)
  - 470 Class Open
  - Enterprise Class Open
  - Laser Standard Men
  - Laser Radial Open
  - Kite Board Open
- 3.2 The Sail Board event will be competed in the RS:X, RS:One, Techno 293 OD and Race-board categories.
- 3.3 The Organising Authority will conduct the Optimist All India Inland Championship 2016 on same dates at Lake Pavana and a separate Notice of Race will be issued for the same.
- 3.4 Current and fully paid up members of the appropriate national class association or state sailing association may enter the regatta.

- 3.5 Crew substitution is not permitted for single-handed classes and case of double-handed classes only for valid reasons as approved in writing by the Organising Authority.
- 3.6 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at registration. The forms are available for download on the event website www.wetnwildregatta.in.
- 3.7 Competitors, coaches and team leaders shall enter by completing the Entry Forms. These forms are available on the event website and can be submitted to the race office: organiser@wetnwildregatta.in.
- 3.8 Entries open on 15 Jun 2016.
- 4. FEES
- 4.1 The following fees shall be paid in full in order to complete the entry:

Single-handed classes – Rs 1500

Double-handed classes – Rs 2000

Coaches, support persons – Rs 2000

- 4.2 Deadline for entries is 01 Aug 2016 after which a Late Entry Fee charge of INR 500 per person will be charged.
- 4.3 Entry fees are not refundable.
- 4.4 Payment details and invoice shall be provided to entrants upon receipt of the entry form.











### 5. FORMAT OF RACING

- 5.1 The regatta will consist of a series of races, with a minimum of 4 races to be completed.
- 5.2 The format for any event may be changed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS
- 6.1 The Championship schedule will be as follows: -

- 6.2 There shall be a maximum of 4 races per class on each day.
- 6.3 There will be no warning signal after 12:00 hrs on the last day.











- 6.4 The regatta functions may be attended by participants and by invitation only. Additional invitations for special guests, coaches and family members may be requested through the race office.
- 6.5 Details of kayaking, mountain biking and other activities and social events will be posted on the event website www.wetnwildregatta.in.
- 7. MEASUREMENT
- 7.1 All boats may be inspected for compliance with the Class Rules.
- 7.2 Any changes to the Equipment Regulations will be posted on the official notice board.
- 7.3 Any boat or equipment may be re-inspected at any time.
- 7.4 Equipment shall only be replaced with permission of the Race Committee.
- 7.5 The Organizing Authority will not supply any equipment and all competitors shall use their own equipment. Equipment that is loaned or chartered shall be considered to be the competitor's own equipment.
- 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
- 8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on 22 Aug 2016 and posted on the event website www.wetnwildregatta.in
- 9. VENUE
- 9.1 The Wet'n Wild Regatta 2016 will be held at Lake Pavana, Lonavala, Maharashtra (see Appendix A Venue).











9.2 The racing area will be in the Lake Pavana. All racing areas are located in close proximity of the designated launch areas (see Appendix A – Venue).

#### 10. THE COURSES

10.1 The courses will be windward / leeward or trapezoid or any special courses as may be designated for the Kite Board event.

#### II. PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 The Sailing Instructions may include a specification of discretionary penalties that may be applied by the Jury for beaches of specified rules.

#### 12. PROTEST COMMITTEE

12.1 A Protest Committee will be appointed in accordance with RRS 91(b). Its decisions will be final as provided in RRS 70.5

#### 13. SCORING

- 13.1 RRS Appendix A will apply. RRS B8 is deleted.
- 13.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute the regatta.
- 13.3 When less than five races in the series have been completed, no score shall be excluded.

#### 14. SUPPORT BOATS

14.1 All coach and support boats shall be registered with the Organising Authority and will be required to comply with local legislation. The Organising Authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.











- 14.2 All coach boats shall display a white flag at all times while afloat clearly visible from both sides of the boat.
- 15. BERTHING
- 15.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.
- 16. RADIO COMMUNICATION
- 16.1 Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing.
- 17. PRIZES
- 17.1 Medals will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each event. The Organising Authority may alter prizes if less than 5 boats are entered in an event.
- 17.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 18. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT
- 18.1 Competitors shall comply with the Athlete Media Guide. The Athlete Media Guide will include further information on television production, tracking, press conferences, interviews and promotion of the regatta.
- 18.2 By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority, their sponsors and the CBYC the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.











- 18.3 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organising Authority.
- 18.4 The top three competitors as well as the individual race winners may be required to attend a media press conference each day.
- 18.5 When requested by the Organising Authority, competitors shall make themselves available to attend photo opportunities, interviews and press conferences at the Championship.

#### 19. INSURANCE

19.1 All participating boats and coach / support boats shall have a valid third-party insurance.

#### 20. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 20.1 All participants competing in the races do so at their own risk and responsibility. See ISAF RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race; "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".
- 20.2 All participants must be aware that the nature of marine sporting activities may include injury or death. By entering the event and completing registration, participants agree:
  - (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
  - (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;











- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission;
- (d) It is the sole responsibility of the participant to ensure their boat is in good order, includes all required safety equipment and equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) At no point in time, either ashore or afloat, is the Organizing Authority, the race management team, patrol boats or any other officials and volunteers responsible for the safety of the participants.
- 20.3 The Organizing Authority, its supporting partners, clubs and any person involved in the organization of the event will not accept any liability for loss, injury or nuisances to people or things, both on the water or ashore, occurring as a result of taking part in the event announced in this Notice of Race.
- 20.4 For all sailors under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian shall sign the disclaimer on the sailor's entry form.




## Appendix A – VENUE INFORMATION
